

CHILDREN'S PONY CLASSES - 10.30am

Entry Fees: €10 per class or €25 for 3 classes.

Entries for these classes will only be taken on the day in the entries tent at the Pony rings.

The classes in the following rings are open to children up to 16 years of age, see each class for age details.

Please note that large classes will be divided.

RED RING

10.30am Class No. HH1 - FIRST RIDDEN Riding class for children under 10 years. Children will be asked to walk and trot individually.

11.30am Class No. HH2 - LEAD REIN for children aged 6 - 8 years.

12.30pm Class No. HH3 - LEAD REIN for children aged 3 - 5 years.

2.00pm Class No. HH4 - FANCY DRESS for pony and rider, any age. Riding hats must be worn.

3.00pm Class No. HH5 - RIDING CLASS for riders aged 10 - 12 years.

4.00pm Class No. HH6 - RIDING CLASS for riders aged 13 - 15 years. Riders will be asked to walk, trot & canter together.

5.00pm Class No. HH7 - PAIRS RIDING CLASS open to riders of any age. Pairs will be asked to do a small individual show, cantering is optional.

GREEN RING

10.30am Class No. HH8 - STYLE & APPEARANCE for riders aged 14 - 16 years.

11.30am Class No. HH9 - STYLE & APPEARANCE for riders aged 11 - 13 years.

12.30pm Class No. HH10 - STYLE & APPEARANCE for riders aged 8 - 10 years.

Riders will be judged on how well the pony & rider are suited to each other and also on turnout. Consideration is given to how much effort the rider puts into the preparation of their pony - its not always the most immaculate pony that wins!

BLUE RING

11.00am - 3.30pm Class No. HH11 - OBEDIENT PONY

TEST A for riders aged 8 - 10 years.

TEST B for riders aged 11 - 13 years.

TEST C for riders aged 14 - 16 years.

This class will take place from 11.00am - 3.30pm. The winner of Test A will be presented with the *Power Perpetual Cup*.

CLEAR ROUND JUMPRING 10.00am - 1.00pm

Entry Fees: €10 Entries taken at Show Jumping ring

Approved Safety Riding Hats and Back Protectors must be worn.

Competitors aged 17 years old and under must be accompanied by a Parent or Guardian.

The Irish Shows Association and the Kilmacanogue Horse Show recommend that exhibitors should extend their insurance policy to include showing.

RING 2 - REGISTERED IRISH DRAUGHT HORSES - 11.00am

Entry Fees: €10. Prizes: 1st €60, 2nd €40, 3rd €25. For Foals: Prizes: 1st €40, 2nd €25, 3rd €20.

There will be a special award for best turned out handler and best young handler in any Draught Class.

CLASS 8 QUALIFIER - I.D. YEARLING FILLY

Sponsored by Hannons Hotel Roscommon. Rules and Conditions: Entries are confined to Irish Draught Yearling Fillies, the progeny of a class 1 R.I.D. Irish Draught Mare or grade up register (AID) Irish Draught Mare and by a class 1 (R.I.D) Irish Draught Stallion. Each entry must have her I.D. passport available for checking by the ISA Representative, both at the Qualifying Show and at the Final to confirm that she is eligible to compete. One animal in each qualifying class may be selected to compete in the final provided the judges agree the standard is high enough. One of the judges at the qualifying show must be from the I.D.H.S. list. Exhibitors to both the qualifier and the final must have the Filly's I.D. Cert ready for inspection prior to entry to the judging ring. Failure to comply with this rule will lead to immediate disqualification. Animals qualified for Final are not eligible to enter any other class at Roscommon Show. These rules should be read in conjunction with the General I.S.A. rules. Entry fee to final: €20 Roscommon Show, Sat 20th August 2011.

Prizes: Champion €500, 2nd €300, 3rd €200, 4th €150, 5th €125, 6th €100, 7th to the end €50.

CLASS 9 I.D. YEARLING FILLY, COLT OR GELDING Prize for best filly if not in first 3.

CLASS 10 QUALIFIER - R.I.D. or I.D. 2 YEAR OLD FILLY CHAMPIONSHIP

Sponsored by Limerick Show Society. Rules and conditions: This Championship is confined to Irish Draught 2 year old Fillies the progeny of a Registered Irish Draught Mare or appendix Mare and R.I.D. Stallion who have qualified at selected ISA Shows this season. Each entry must have her passport available for checking by the I.S.A. Representative, both at the Qualifying Show and at the Final, to confirm that she is eligible to compete. No filly will be allowed to compete unless her passport is in order. Two animals in each qualifying class may be selected to compete in the final provided the judges agree the standard is high enough. One of the judges at the qualifying show must be from the Irish Draught Horse Society list. Animals qualified for Final are not eligible to enter any other class at Limerick Show. Entry fee to final: €20. Limerick Show, Sunday 28th August 2011.

Prizes: Champion €500, 2nd €300, 3rd €250, 4th €200, 5th €150, 6th €100, 7th to the end €50.

CLASS 11 2 YEAR OLD FILLY R.I.D. or I.D.

CLASS 12 QUALIFIER - R.I.D. or I.D. 3 YEAR OLD MARE CHAMPIONSHIP

Sponsored by The Diamond Coast Hotel, Enniscrone, Co. Sligo. Rules and conditions: This Championship is confined to Irish Draught 3 year old Mares the progeny of a Registered Irish Draught Mare or appendix Mare and R.I.D. Stallion who has qualified at selected I.S.A shows this season. Each exhibitor must have the mares passport available for checking by the I.S.A. representative both at the qualifying show and at the final. No mare will be allowed to compete unless her passport is in order. Two mares in each qualifying class may be selected to compete in the final provided the judges agree the standard is high enough. One of the judges at the qualifying show must be from the Irish Draught Horse Society list. Mares qualified for this final are not eligible to enter any other class at Bonnicconlon Show. These rules should be read in conjunction with the I.S.A. rules. Entry fee to final: €20. Bonnicconlon Show, Monday 1st August 2011.

Prizes: Champion €600, 2nd €400, 3rd €200, 4th €150, 5th €100, 6th €80, 7th to the end €50.

CLASS 13 3 YEAR OLD FILLY R.I.D. or I.D.

CLASS 14 R.I.D. or A.I.D. BROODMARE stunted in foal or with foal at foot. Covering cert must be produced. Winner will be presented with the *Irish Draught Society Perpetual Cup* and a nomination to 'Glenanreen Prince'.

CLASS 15 R.I.D. or A.I.D. BROODMARE with foal at foot. Mare and Foal to be judged as a unit. Winner will be presented with the *Stephens of Ashford Perpetual Cup* & €150. 2nd Place €100. Sponsored by James Heery.

CLASS 16 QUALIFIER - I.D. FILLY FOAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Sponsored by Parkmore Equestrian Centre. Rules and Conditions: Entries are confined to I.D. Filly Foals the progeny of a class 1 (R.I.D) Irish Draught Mare and by a class 1 (R.I.D) Irish Draught Stallion. Dams passports must be produced at qualifying shows and at the final. Foals passport must be produced at the final. Foals must be led at all times. One foal from selected shows may qualify for the final if the judges and the I.S.A. agree the standard is high enough. One of the judges at the qualifying show must be from the I.D.H.S. list. Foals qualified for final are not eligible to enter any other class at Ballinasloe Show. Entry fee to final: €20. Ballinasloe Show, Saturday 1st October 2011.

Prizes: Champion €800 & Trophy, 2nd €400, 3rd €300, 4th €200, 5th €150, 6th €100, 7th to the end €50.
